There are six rows of graves in Gnaden Huetten Cemetery, the last row where Ruth Lashman is buried, being next to the storage shed, , and proceeding uphill to row 1, where the rest of our ancestors are buried. The layout of Lehighton Cemetery is divided into sections with a letter prefix for each section. There is a map in the cemetery office/garage to pinpoint the exact location of any particular grave. ST. JOHN'S BURYING GROUND, EASTON, PA.

The two maps following are of the east side and the southwest corner of the cemetery. They probably were drawn after 1871, but before 1889, because it was at that time that St. John's Church expanded their facility and covered part of the cemetery. Existing records indicate that the grave markers were moved or relocated, but do not say where to. Perhaps the graves were left undisturbed, but the records give no insight into this. Today the entire area (except for one small patch) is covered either by structures or paved parking lots.

The Lutherans laid the cornerstone for their own church building (the present one) in 1830 on the corner of Fourth and Ferry Streets. A Sunday School facility was added in 1889 over a portion of what was the cemetery, preserving some historic gravestones in the 'grave cellar'. On Heritage Day, the 'grave cellar' is opened for visitors. In 1962 as other downtown congregations were moving to the suburbs, the former German speaking congregation, Zion Lutheran Church, and St. John's chose to remain in the city and they reunited.

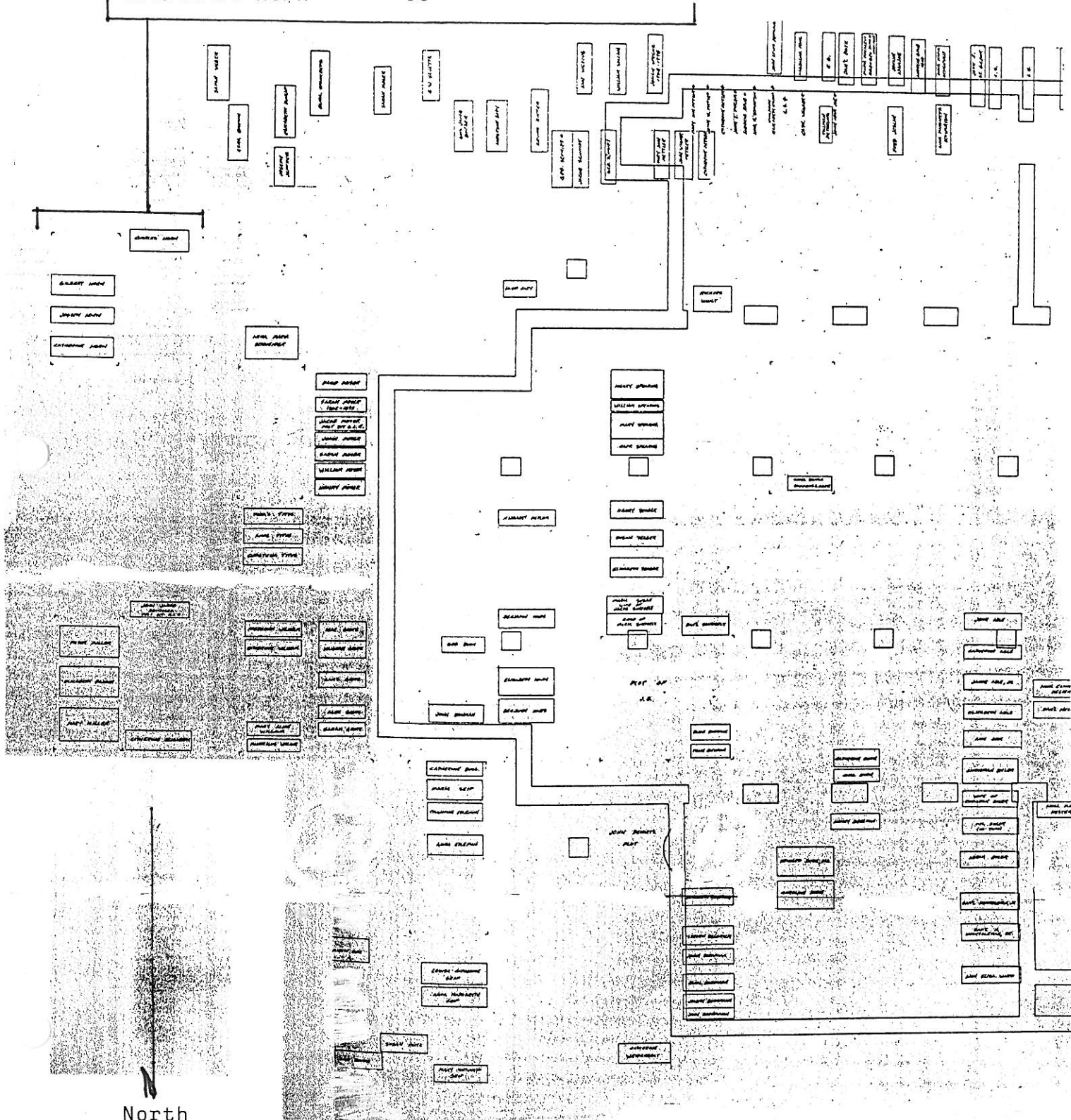

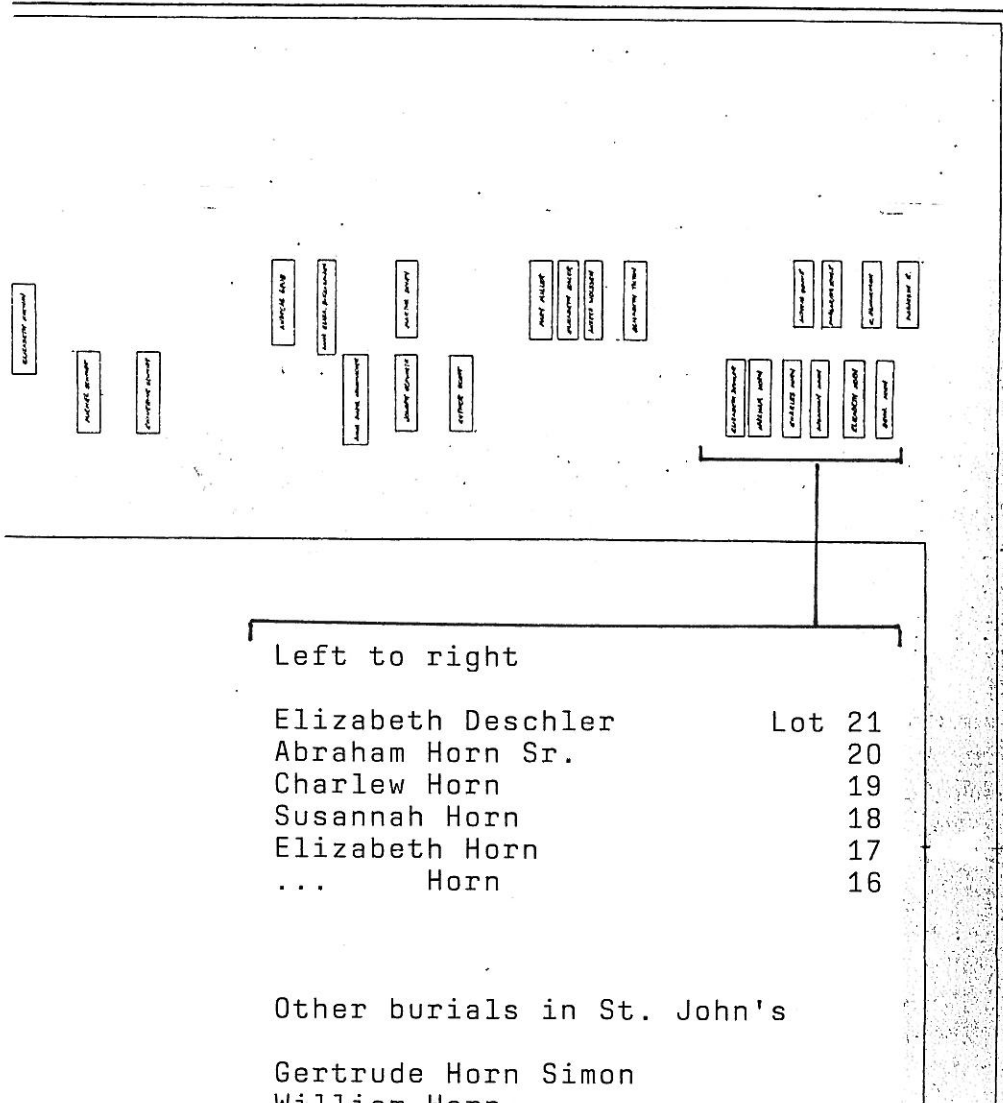

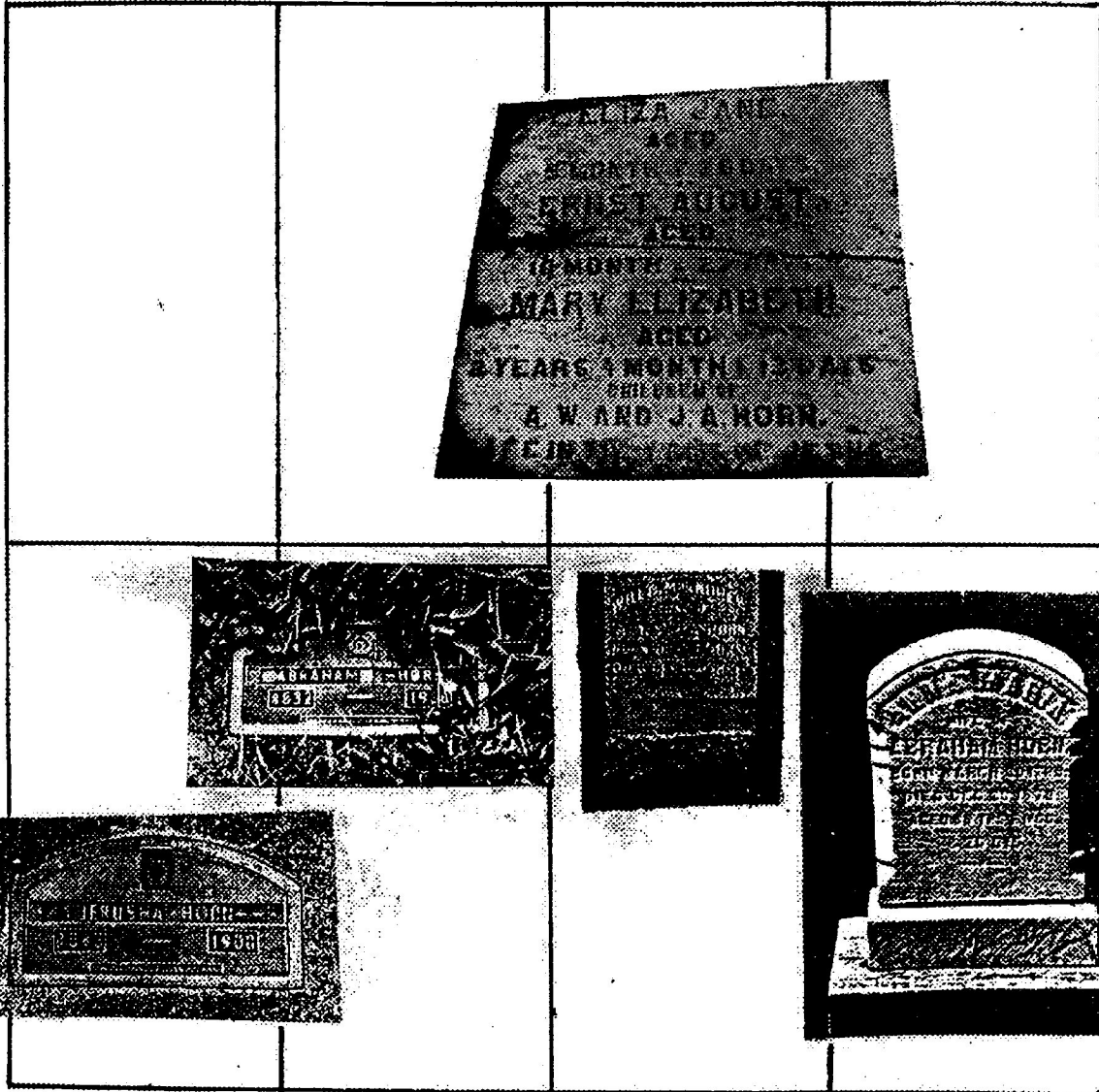

OLD ALLENTOWN CEMETERY

This cemetery, located on Linden St., between 9th and 10th Sts., was created by William Allen as the graveyard for his community. Today it is a park, maintained by the city of Allentown. The old grave markers have been laid flat on cement slabs.

Several surveys have been used in attempting to locate our ancestors' graves. The oldest, done by the Civilian Conservation Corps in the Depression era, assigned numbers to each of the graves, and this is the source used by Arthur M. Horn Sr. in the 70's when he transcribed the engravings on the markers. Unfortunately, he described the grave locations verbally, rather than by a map. The second, an informal survey conducted by another historian, Charles Kerchner, descended from the Laudenschlaegers, located his ancestors and used the numbers assigned by the CCC. Unfortunately, there are no common ancestors to aid in our efforts. The third survey, copied by a Linda Klosek in September 2003, and obtained from the Lehigh County Historical Society, is laid out by rows, and lists the graves in each row. The Laudenschlaeger graves are in the new part of the cemetery, and do not appear on the map. Mr. Kerchner's map, with our area of interest marked, follows.

William Allen was a prominent figure in Allentown history, the town being renamed from Northampton Town to Allentown in his honor. His daughter, Ann P. Greenleaf, is the same person who sold lot 432 to Abraham Horn Sr. (see Document section).

The ROSS-Private-Family Grave-yard

This graveyard is situated in a field approximately two hundred yards past the old stone "manor house" bearing a sign ROSS COMMON. This is situated about two miles north of Wind Gap on the road leading to Saylorsburg. The graveyard has a lone tree in it, and is surrounded by a wall 25 or 30 feet to a side and 4 feet high. There are seven tombstones and a recent new granite stone which summarizes the information on three of the older ones to its right. Two of the upright stones are illegible. Following is the layout.

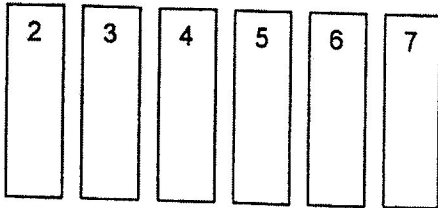
